

## Eligible Members

Except for those members specifically excluded as Ineligible Members below, all members listed as a Named Insured on a medical liability insurance policy issued by The Doctors Company in force on or after January 1, 2007, are eligible to participate in the Tribute Plan.

## Ineligible Members

The following persons and entities are not eligible to participate in the Tribute Plan:

- Members whose coverage with The Doctors Company terminated prior to January 1, 2007, and who are not listed as a Named Insured on a medical liability insurance policy issued by The Doctors Company on or after that date.
- Members who obtained extended reporting (tail) coverage from The Doctors Company (whether by purchase or waiver of premium) prior to January 1, 2007, and who are not listed as a Named Insured on a medical liability insurance policy issued by The Doctors Company with an effective date on or after January 1, 2007.
- Members who died, who became permanently disabled, or who permanently retired prior to January 1, 2007.
- Ancillary Insureds.
- Slot Physicians.
- Auxiliary Physicians.
- Former Insureds.
- Hospitals, laboratories, emergency rooms, and surgicenters.
- Any business entity including, but not limited to, corporation, partnership, limited liability company, joint venture, association, joint stock company, trust, or unincorporated association or organization.
- Non-physicians (other than dentists, chiropractors, and podiatrists).
- Policyholders of any subsidiary or affiliate of The Doctors Company (except to the extent The Doctors Company has agreed in writing to allow any such member to participate in the Tribute Plan).

## Definitions

“**Ancillary Insureds**” are non-physician health care providers who hold one or more of the following licenses: Physician’s Assistant, Certified Nurse Practitioner, Certified Nurse Midwife, or Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist.

“**Auxiliary Physicians**” are physicians engaged by the Named Insured on a limited basis, sharing limits with the Named Insured, as defined in the medical liability insurance policy issued by The Doctors Company.

# The Tribute® Plan—Participation Eligibility

## Definitions (cont.)

“**Former Insureds**” are physicians or other health care providers for whom coverage is provided only for reporting claims, rather than active coverage, and are listed or described as a Former Insured on a medical liability insurance policy issued by The Doctors Company.

“**Named Insured**” is as defined in the member’s medical liability insurance policy issued by The Doctors Company.

“**Slot Physicians**” are physicians with slot coverage (a limit of liability option whereby limits attach to “slots” or positions, rather than to individual practitioners) as defined in the medical liability insurance policy issued by The Doctors Company.

This document does not purport to describe all the terms and conditions of the Tribute Plan. The Plan Document contains a full description of the Tribute Plan.
